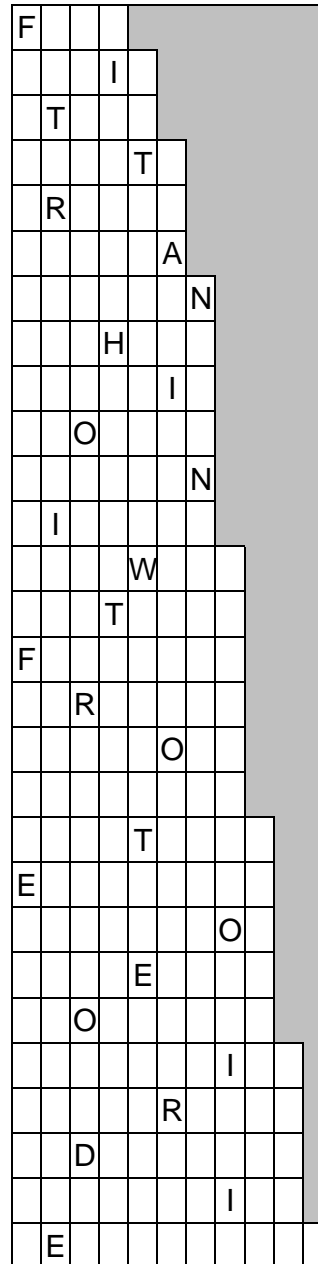


# JAMES MONROE!



\_\_\_ states were admitted into the Union during his presidency  
 The \_\_\_ of 1819 was the first major financial crisis in the U.S.  
 He became Secretary of \_\_\_ in 1811  
 He was elected to the \_\_\_ Continental Congress in 1783  
 From 1794-1796 he was the ambassador to \_\_\_  
 \_\_\_ claimed the Pacific coast down to the fifty-first parallel  
 Was a member of the \_\_\_ Colonization Society  
 He appointed John C. \_\_\_ as his Secretary of War  
 General Washington promoted him to \_\_\_ in the Revolutionary War  
 In the Transcontinental Treaty of 1819, Spain ceded \_\_\_ to the U.S.  
 Was wounded in the Battle of \_\_\_ in December 1776  
 Left the College of \_\_\_ and Mary to join the Continental Army in 1776  
 In "Washington Crossing the \_\_\_," he is depicted holding the flag  
 The Monroe \_\_\_ of 1823: no European intervention in the Americas  
 He was the last president to be considered a \_\_\_ Father  
 During the Era of Good Feelings, there was very little \_\_\_ strife  
 Sent General Andrew Jackson to fight the \_\_\_ Indians in Florida  
 Was Governor of this state twice, the second time only for few months  
 He replaced John \_\_\_ as Secretary of War in 1814  
 Didn't want the \_\_\_ branch of government to have too much power  
 Studied law under this future president from 1780-83  
 John Quincy Adams was his \_\_\_ of State  
 He ran \_\_\_ in his bid for reelection in 1820  
 The Missouri \_\_\_ was passed in 1820  
 He vetoed the \_\_\_ Road Bill  
 Was an anti-\_\_\_ and opposed ratification of the Constitution  
 Believed in the French \_\_\_, so was opposed to Jay's Treaty in 1795  
 He died in \_\_\_ \_\_\_ \_\_\_ on July 4, 1831
