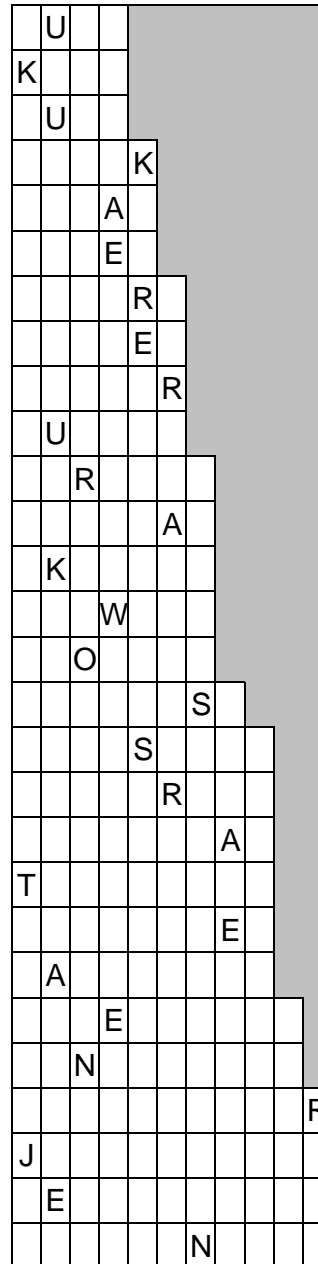


ROOTS OF METAL!



Grand ___ Railroad declared "We're An American Band" in 1973
 This group is easily recognized by their trademark face paint
 This Canadian band sang "Tom Sawyer" and "Limelight"
 In 1979 Ozzy Osbourne was kicked out of ___ Sabbath for drug use
 This 1960s group included Eric Clapton, Jack Bruce & Ginger Baker
 Their "Bohemian Rhapsody" was released in 1975
 ___ Tull sang the classic "Locomotive Breath" in 1971
 Iron ___ is recognizable by their mascot 'Eddie'
 Blue ___ Cult is known for their 1976 single "(Don't Fear) The Reaper"
 Deep ___ formed in 1968, disbanded in 1976, and reunited in 1984
 Dutch rock group Golden ___ sang "Radar Love" in 1973
 AC/DC released "___ to Hell" in 1979
 The Beatles' 1968 single "Helter ___" is considered early metal
 Rod ___ was the lead singer for The Jeff Beck Group in 1968
 Iggy Pop was lead singer of The ___ from 1967-1974, and again in 2003
 Sammy Hagar was the lead singer of ___ before going solo in 1976
 This group's most well known members are Steven Tyler and Joe Perry
 Iron ___ is best known for the song "In-A-Gadda-Da-Vida"
 This band had a drummer called Phil "Philthy Animal" Taylor
 Irish rock band best known for "The Boys Are Back In Town" in 1976
 This British group got their name from the book David Copperfield
 Jimmy Page, Jeff Beck and Eric Clapton were all part of The ___
 The Jimi Hendrix ___ released "Purple Haze" in 1967
 The Who's first album was My ___ in 1965
 He took his band's name as his own and is known for "shock rock"
 After Rob Halford left, this group hired a singer from a tribute band
 Jimmy Page, Robert Plant, John Bonham & John Paul Jones
 They sang "Born To Be Wild" and "Magic Carpet Ride"
